requiring patient informed consent in violation of the Nuremberg code of 1947, 50 under some Practice Improvement Modules^{6,7}; therefore be it 51 52 53 **RESOLVED:** That MSMS seek legislation in Michigan that will prohibit discrimination by hospitals and any employer, the Michigan Board of Medicine, 54 insurers, Medicare, Medicaid, and other entities, which might restrict a 55 physician's right to practice medicine without interference (including economic 56 discrimination by varying fee schedules) due to lack of participation in 57 prescribed corporate programs including Maintenance of Certification or 58 expiration of time limited board certification. 59 60
